This activity is designed to get you to think about a bit about your future in a fun way. There is nothing at stake here. It's just an exercise.

It's tricky to plan for everything and plans can change, but it can be useful to have a **direction** and a think about how you might like things to be.

Let's imagine that *someone* gave you \$2000 dollars a month after high school graduation no strings attached for one year! What would you do? What would you *really* do?

1. Write down what your plan would be for the **2 years** following graduation. You only get the cash for one year.

Things to consider (things to consider):

- The cash runs out after 1 year.
- You'll have to pay your own rent and pay for your own food.
- You need a plan for **2 years** not just 1.
- The Money doesn't necessarily have to change your plans. You can still go to school/work or do whatever you wanted to before you got the scholarship.
