

More CSS. External Stylesheets

As you learn more CSS and add more styling to your webpages, you might want to use a **separate page** to store your styling code.



External stylesheets allow you to completely **separate** your CSS from your HTML. This keeps code neat, organized, and much easier work with.

If you are using **CodePen**, You don't have to do anything to link your CSS page to your HTML page. You can just compose CSS in the CSS window provided and it should style the tags on your HTML page just like it did when you put styling within the styling tags on your HTML page.

If you are **not** using CodePen you will have to **link** your CSS page with a link in the header tag like the following example:

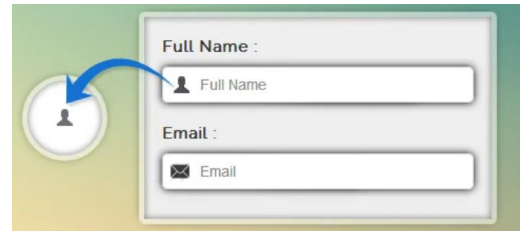
Exercise#1

Making a more functional webpage with: USER INPUT
