7. Some styling if you can.



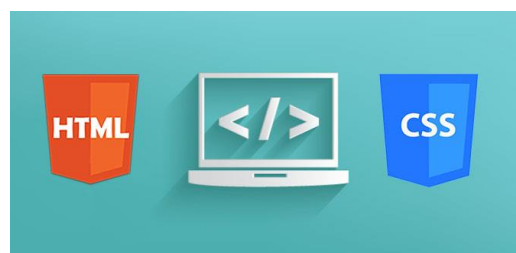
USE the “HTML element tags” link on the course site to see what cool element you can add to a webpage. Add as many as you wish in addition to the ones above.
